31 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 33 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - GRANTS TO COMMUNITY BASED PROVIDERS. Funds
 34 allocated for community-based services under the appropriation for (i) the
 35 Grants-in-Aid appropriation in this act, (ii) the Grants/Patient Services
 36 Line in the Operations appropriation in this act, and (iii) the Inter-

1 Divisional Programs appropriation in this act, shall be used only to provide
2 services through private community based services licensed or certified by
3 the Arkansas Division of Developmental Disabilities Services (DDS) or
4 licensed or certified by a Provider-Led Arkansas Shared Savings Entity
5 (PASSE). Non-profit community-based programs licensed by the Division of
6 Developmental Disabilities Services are quasi-governmental instrumentalities
7 of the state which provide supports and services to individuals who have a
8 developmental disability or delay, who would otherwise require supports and
9 services through state-operated programs and facilities owned by the State of
10 Arkansas. When licensed providers are involved in delivering services which
11 are Medicaid reimbursable, they must enroll as a provider with the Arkansas
12 Medicaid Program and must bill the Arkansas Medicaid Program for all covered
13 services for eligible individuals.

14 Services which are covered by the Arkansas State Medicaid Program,
15 including the Provider-Led Arkansas Shared Savings Entity (PASSE) model, will
16 be utilized to the maximum extent possible for any individual who is eligible
17 for Medicaid coverage. It is the intent of this section that DDS, as a
18 general policy, maximize the use of Medicaid funding available for
19 appropriate services.

20 Licensed private community providers funded from these appropriations for
21 community based services shall:

- 22 1. Screen each individual to whom services are provided for a determination
23 of eligibility or ineligibility for Medicaid coverage within thirty days of
24 the first date that services are provided.
- 25 2. Meet minimum standards of performance in the delivery of services to
26 people with disabilities as defined by the Department of Human Services -
27 Division of Developmental Disabilities Services.
- 28 3. Supply statistical and financial data to the Department of Human Services
29 - Division of Developmental Disabilities Services.
- 30 4. Establish and maintain a sound financial management system in accordance
31 with guidelines as set forth by the Department of Human Services.
- 32 5. Establish and maintain community support programs designed to provide
33 coordinated care and treatment to ensure ongoing involvement and
34 individualized services for persons with disabilities.

35 It is the intent of this section to insure that wherever possible and
36 appropriate, Medicaid funds are utilized.

1 Nothing in this Act shall prevent the Division or any provider from
2 extending emergency services when appropriate measures have been taken in a
3 timely manner to secure Medicaid eligibility.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
5 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

6
7 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

9 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - VOCATIONAL TRAINEES. The Division of
10 Developmental Disabilities Services of the Department of Human Services is
11 hereby authorized to provide employment opportunities for people with
12 developmental disabilities residing at the Human Development Centers who work
13 at less than a competitive employment level.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
15 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

16
17 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

19 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
20 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized
21 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to
22 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be
23 held by the Department of Human Services - Division of Developmental
24 Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be
25 harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities
26 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately.
27 The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to
28 finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the purchase of
29 major capital equipment.

30 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all
31 income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
32 State and the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Any
33 contracts initiated for the harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the
34 Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
35 Committee for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale
36 of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
2 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

4 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

6 DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.

7 (A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of
8 Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human
9 Development Centers which are located at Conway, Arkadelphia, Jonesboro,
10 Booneville, and Warren.

11 (B) The Department of Human Services shall continue to accept clients for
12 whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are needed at
13 state administered Human Development Centers and Community Programs licensed
14 by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been determined in
15 accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the community.

16 (C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community based
17 services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community
18 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-
19 Aid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly benefit(s) community based
20 services for persons with developmental disabilities or from the
21 appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s)
22 directly benefit(s) the Human Development Centers.

23 (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of July 1, ~~2021~~ 2022 from the
24 Grants to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities
25 Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with developmental
26 disabilities or from any other general revenues as of July 1, ~~2021~~ 2022,
27 applied as federal matching funds for community based services licensed by
28 DDS on July 1, ~~2021~~ 2022 be reduced below the approved funding level on July
29 1, ~~2021~~ 2022; nor shall the general revenues applied as federal matching
30 funds for the Human Development Centers be reduced below the approved funding
31 level on July 1, ~~2021~~ 2022.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
33 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

35 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

1 ELIMINATION OF AUTISM WAIVER SERVICES WAITING LIST. Immediately upon the
2 effective date of this Act, the Department of Human Services - Division of
3 Developmental Disabilities Services shall budget, allocate, and expend up to
4 one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the elimination of the Autism Waiver
5 Services Program waiting list.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
7 ~~2021~~ 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

8

9 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

18

19 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28 SECTION 18. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
29 2022.
