SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. APPROPRIATION AND FUND TRANSFERS. After receiving approval from the Chief 30 31 Fiscal Officer of the State, the Director of the Arkansas Economic 32 Development Commission is authorized to transfer appropriation and funds from 33 the Division of Science and Technology State Operations - Arkansas

34 Acceleration Fund Programs line item within the Arkansas Economic Development 35 Commission Fund Account to the Arkansas Acceleration Fund. The total of all 36 transfers shall not exceed \$3,500,000.

The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish, 7 upon request from the Arkansas Economic Development Commission, a special 8 appropriation line item to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. 9 When the Arkansas Economic Development Commission wishes to transfer from its 10 operating expenses to promotional items, the request shall be forwarded to 11 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for processing after prior approval by 12 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 13 14 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 15 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 16 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 17 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 18 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization Law. Further, the General Assembly 19 has determined that the Arkansas Economic Development Commission may operate 20 more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission authorizing broad powers under this Section. 21 22 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 23 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or 24 Joint Budget Committee as provided by this Section. The requirement of 25 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a 26 severable part of this Section. If the requirement of approval by the 27 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 28

 AWARD CRITERIA. The Rural Services Division of the Arkansas Economic
