8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
10 HEALTH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH  
14 REAPPROPRIATION.

16  
17

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT FUND. There  
21 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Health, to be payable from the  
22 Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Health the following:

23 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
24 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 176 of 2021, for personal services of the  
25 Office of Health Information Technology (OHIT), for the State Health Alliance  
26 for Records Exchange (SHARE), and for grants to rural or critical access  
27 hospitals, in a sum not to exceed .....\$5,615.  
28

29 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is  
30 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Health, to be payable from the  
31 Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Health the following:

32 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
33 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for elevator modernization, in a  
34 sum not to exceed .....\$2,100,000.

35 (B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
36 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for roof renovations at the Main



1 Campus, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,759,900.

2 (C) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
3 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for restroom renovations at the  
4 Main Campus, in a sum not to exceed .....\$880,940.

5 (D) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
6 in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for a fire alarm system upgrade  
7 at the Main Campus, in a sum not to exceed .....\$540,000.

8 (E) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
9 in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for replacement of the cooling  
10 tower at the Main Campus, in a sum not to exceed .....\$425,172.

11 (F) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
12 in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for conversion of the steam  
13 plant at the Main Campus, in a sum not to exceed .....\$867,000.

14 (G) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
15 in Item (G) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for chilled water piping  
16 upgrades at the Main Campus, in a sum not to exceed .....\$734,952.

17 (H) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
18 in Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for HVAC, domestic water riser  
19 renovations at the Main Campus, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,025,000.

20 (I) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
21 in Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for basement through 4th floor  
22 HVAC renovations at the Main Campus, in a sum not to exceed .....\$948,145.

23 (J) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
24 in Item (J) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for surface parking repairs and  
25 renovation at the Main Campus, in a sum not to exceed .....\$900,000.

26 (K) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
27 in Item (K) of Section 1 of Act 850 of 2021, for restructure of the office  
28 space for the Tobacco Prevention and Cessation Program, in a sum not to  
29 exceed .....\$69,001.

30  
31 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
32 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
33 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
34 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
35 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
36 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or

1 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
2 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
3 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
4 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
5 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
6 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

7 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
8 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
9 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
10 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
11 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
12 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
13 otherwise by law.

14  
15 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23  
24 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,  
25 2022.
