## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF THE  
10 MILITARY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

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13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF THE MILITARY  
14 REAPPROPRIATION.  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is  
21 hereby appropriated, to the Department of the Military, to be payable from  
22 the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of the Military the  
23 following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
25 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 854 of 2021, for construction of a Readiness  
26 Center Joint Force Headquarters at Camp Joseph T. Robinson, in a sum not to  
27 exceed .....\$1,852,606.  
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29 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL CAPITAL PROJECTS. There is hereby  
30 appropriated, to the Department of the Military, to be payable from the  
31 federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the  
32 Department of the Military the following:

33 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
34 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 854 of 2021, for construction of a Readiness  
35 Center Joint Force Headquarters at Camp Joseph T. Robinson, in a sum not to  
36 exceed .....\$5,557,817.



1 (B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
2 in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 854 of 2021, for a Multi-Purpose Machinegun  
3 Range at Camp Joseph T. Robinson, in a sum not to exceed .....\$8,000,000.

4 (C) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
5 in Item (C) of Section 2 of Act 854 of 2021, for an RMTc Redundant Water  
6 Storage Tank at Camp Joseph T. Robinson, in a sum not to exceed ..\$4,065,000.

7 (D) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
8 in Item (D) of Section 2 of Act 854 of 2021, for the Fort Chaffee Solar Array  
9 Project, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,867,890.

10 (E) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
11 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 178 of 2021, for construction and renovation  
12 of Professional Education Center Dining Facility, in a sum not to exceed  
13 .....\$1,039,703.

14 (F) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
15 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 178 of 2021, for construction of a Readiness  
16 Center Joint Force Headquarters at Camp Joseph T. Robinson, in a sum not to  
17 exceed .....\$43,000,608.

18 (G) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
19 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 178 of 2021, for construction and expansion  
20 of the Professional Education Center (PEC) Dining Facility, in a sum not to  
21 exceed .....\$3,500,000.

22 (H) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
23 in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 178 of 2021, for construction of a Readiness  
24 Center at Fort Chaffee, in a sum not to exceed .....\$12,747,217.

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26 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - ARMORY CONSTRUCTION FUND CAPITAL PROJECTS.

27 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of the Military, to be  
28 payable from the Armory Construction Fund, for the Department of the Military  
29 the following:

30 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
31 in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 854 of 2021, for repair, construction,  
32 renovation, landscaping, maintenance, improvement, or equipping of armories,  
33 hangars and other properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas  
34 National Guard, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,500,000.

35 (B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
36 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 178 of 2021, for repair, construction,

1 renovation, landscaping and maintenance of armories, hangars, and other  
2 properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas National Guard, in a  
3 sum not to exceed .....\$1,849,785.

4 (C) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided  
5 in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 178 of 2021, for repair, construction,  
6 renovation, landscaping and maintenance of armories, hangars and other  
7 properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas National Guard, in a  
8 sum not to exceed .....\$2,500,000.

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10 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
11 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
12 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
13 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
14 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
15 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
16 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
17 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
18 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
19 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
20 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
21 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

22 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
23 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
24 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
25 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
26 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
27 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
28 otherwise by law.

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30 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
32 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
33 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
36 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1, 2022.
