9	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 77, Subchapter 1, is		
10	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
11	20-77-148. Continuous glucose monitor — Definition.		
12	(a) As used in this section, "continuous glucose monitor" means an		
13	instrument or device, including repair and replacement parts, that:		
14	(1) Is designed and offered for the purpose of aiding an		
15	individual with diabetes;		
16	(2) Measures glucose levels at set intervals by means of a small		
17	electrode placed under the skin and held in place by an adhesive; and		
18	(3) Is generally not useful to an individual who has not been		
19	diagnosed with diabetes.		
20	(b) The Arkansas Medicaid Program shall provide coverage for a		
21	continuous glucose monitor for the treatment of an individual if the		
22	individual has:		
23	(1) Either:		
24	(A) A presence of type 1 diabetes or any other type of		
25	diabetes with:		
26	(i) The use of insulin more than two (2) times		
27	daily; or		
28	(ii) Evidence of Level 2 or Level 3 hypoglycemia; or		
29	(B) Diagnosis of glycogen storage disease type la; and		
30	(2) Regular follow-up visits with a healthcare provider at a		
31	minimum of every six (6) months to assess for ongoing benefit of the		
32	continuous glucose monitor.		
33	(c) Coverage for a continuous glucose monitor under the Arkansas		
34	Medicaid Program shall allow the beneficiary to obtain a continuous glucose		
35	monitor through a prescription at a pharmacy and be eligible for rebates as a		
36	pharmacy benefit.
