7	(1) "Birth" means delivery of a newborn child either by vaginal		
8	delivery or Cesarean section;		
9	(2)(A) "Health benefit plan" means an individual, blanket, or		
10	group plan or a policy or contract for healthcare services issued or		
11	delivered by a healthcare insurer.		
12	(B) "Health benefit plan" includes:		
13	(i) Indemnity and managed care plans; and		
14	<u>(ii) Nonfederal governmental plans as defined in 29</u>		
15	U.S.C. § 1002(32), as it existed on January 1, 2024.		
16	(C) "Health benefit plan" does not include:		
17	(i) A disability income plan;		
18	(ii) A credit insurance plan;		
19	(iii) Insurance coverage issued as a supplement to		
20	<u>liability insurance;</u>		
21	(iv) A medical payment under automobile or		
22	homeowner's insurance plans;		
23	(v) A health benefit plan provided under Arkansas		
24	Constitution, Article 5, § 32, the Workers' Compensation Law, § 11-9-101 et

9	Procedural Terminology codes or the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System

11	(c) A healthcare insurer shall use the reimbursement rate for a birth
12	by Cesarean section to reimburse a healthcare professional for a birth in
13	this state.
