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6 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 8 DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS. Funding provided in Property Tax Relief Fund Revenues 9 Distribution to Counties and Property Tax Relief Fund Revenues Distribution to 10 Cities of this Act from the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund shall not be 11 distributed unless there are sufficient funds in the Property Tax Relief Trust 12 Fund as of the date that the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State certifies the 13 amount in excess of the required reimbursement to the counties as provided in 14 §26-26-310(b)(2)(C)(i). If there are sufficient funds remaining in the 15 Property Tax Relief Trust Fund on December 31, 2022 2023, as certified, the 16 Treasurer shall distribute two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to counties and 17 two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to cities for the fiscal year ending June 30, 18 2023 2024 from the balance remaining on December 31, 2022 2023 from the 19 Property Tax Relief Trust Fund. The distribution to counties shall be made in 20 accordance with the distribution formula in §19-5-602(c). The distribution to 21 cities shall be made in accordance with the distribution formula in §19-5-22 601(b). The funds attributable to sales and use taxes levied prior to July 1, 23 2022 2023 shall not be transferred from the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund to 24 the cities and counties. 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2022 26 2023 through June 30, 2023 2024. 27 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 19-5-28 29 602, concerning the County Aid Fund, is amended to codify special language in 30 appropriation acts by adding an additional subsection to read as follows: 31 (e) Any appropriation provided by the General Assembly for aid to 32 counties may be supplemented, if necessary, by a transfer from an 33 appropriation provided for unanticipated special revenues.

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35 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

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1 LOANS TO CITIES AND COUNTIES. On July 1 of each fiscal year, the Chief 2 Fiscal Officer of the State shall request a transfer by the State Treasurer from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund to the County Aid Fund and to the 3 4 Municipal Aid Fund to assist the various cities and counties in meeting cash 5 flow needs early in the state fiscal year. The transfer shall be a loan to 6 be repaid in equal installments from general revenue distributions each month 7 during the fiscal year for which the loan was made and shall be in addition 8 to any other loans authorized by law for the County Aid and Municipal Aid 9 The amount of such loan for each fiscal year shall be \$3,517,657 to Funds. 10 the Municipal Aid Fund and \$1,906,079 to the County Aid Fund, or so much 11 thereof as may be available in the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund as 12 determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Upon such transfer 13 being completed, the State Treasurer shall immediately distribute such funds 14 to each of the several municipalities and counties in the same manner as 15 general revenues are distributed.

16 It is the intent of the General Assembly that the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 17 State and the State Treasurer shall make every reasonable, and financially 18 sound effort to insure that local governments receive the full amount of the 19 loan authorized herein on July 1 of each year and that the monies authorized 20 for local governments from general revenues be distributed in equal monthly 21 payments.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2022 23 <u>2023</u> through June 30, 2023 <u>2024</u>.

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25 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

27 CARRY FORWARD. At the close of each fiscal year any unexpended funds for the 28 County Aid and Municipal Aid line items shall be carried forward and 29 distributed pursuant and in addition to the funding formula established under

30 A.C.A 19-5-601 and 19-5-602 within forty-five (45) days.

31 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, 32 may be carried forward under the following conditions:

(1) Prior to June 30, 2023 2024 the Agency shall by written statement
set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

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(2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall

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report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
 written request set forth in (1) above;

7 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a 8 written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 9 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written 10 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for 11 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 12 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents 13 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 14 Committee; and

15 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall 16 include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals 17 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or 18 Institution.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2022
20 2023 through June 30, 2023 2024.

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SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 22 23 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 24 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 25 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 26 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 27 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 28 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 30 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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32 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 33 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 34 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 35 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 36 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

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1	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or				
2	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative				
3	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.				
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5	SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the				
6	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits				
7	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the				
8	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of				
9	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in				
10	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the				
11	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm				
12	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental				
13	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act				
14	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health				
15	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.				
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
