4	(b) The Regular Salaries line item in the Operations section of the
5	operative appropriation act for Arkansas Legislative Audit shall not be
6	increased or decreased by a transfer under subsection (a) of this section
7	until the transfer is reviewed by the:
8	(1) Legislative Council; or
9	(2) Joint Budget Committee, if the General Assembly is in
10	session.

12	SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 10,
13	Chapter 4, Subchapter 4, is amended to add an additional section to read as
14	follows:
15	<u>10-4-431. Salaries - Arkansas Legislative Audit.</u>
16	(a) Any adjustments in annual salary rates for employees, labor market
17	adjustments, merit pay adjustments, or employee retention or recruitment
18	requirements shall be made at the discretion of the Legislative Auditor.
19	(b)(1) In addition to other salary payments under this section, the
20	Legislative Auditor may implement a merit program to reward employees for
21	exceptional service.
22	(2) The merit program under subdivision (b)(1) of this section
23	shall be approved by the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee before
24	implementation of the merit program.
25	(c) In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be
26	recruited and retained, Arkansas Legislative Audit may exceed the maximum
27	salary levels by no more than twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third
28	(1/3) of the positions authorized in its operative appropriation act after
29	receiving approval from the:
30	(1) Legislative Council; or
31	(2) Joint Budget Committee, if the General Assembly is in
32	session.
33	(d) Salary payments under this section shall not be restricted to
34	maximum amounts authorized by law.
35	
36	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 10,

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Chapter 4, Subchapter 4, is amended to add an additional section to read as
 follows:

3 <u>10-4-432.</u> Funds received in connection with Arkansas Scholarship
4 Lottery Act.

5 <u>Funds received by Arkansas Legislative Audit for performing its duties</u>
6 <u>under the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Act, § 23-114-101 et seq., shall be</u>
7 <u>deposited into the State Central Services Fund to be utilized solely by</u>
8 <u>Arkansas Legislative Audit in performing those duties.</u>

10 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 11 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 13 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

20 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 28

SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 29 30 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 31 32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of 33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm 35 36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

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1	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
2	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
3	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
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
