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27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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29 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-3-306(a)(2), concerning the property tax
30 exemption for disabled veterans, surviving spouses, and minor dependent
31 children, is amended to read as follows:

32 (2) As used in this section:

33 (A) "Homestead" means the:

34 (i) Dwelling that a disabled veteran, surviving
35 spouse of a disabled veteran, or minor dependent child of a disabled veteran
36 occupies as his or her principal place of residence; and



1 (ii) Real property contiguous to the dwelling under
2 subdivision (a)(2)(A)(i) of this section if the contiguous property is not
3 being used for a commercial purpose; and

4 (B) "~~personal~~ Personal property" means only those items of
5 tangible personal property used for other than a commercial or business
6 purpose.

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8 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 1 of this act is effective for
9 assessment years beginning on or after January 1, 2023.
