4	one's ability to live independently, make it difficult to maintain		
5	employment, and lead a normal life;		
6	(7) One (1) in three (3) people diagnosed with lupus is disable		
7	by the disease and consequently receives support from government programs,		
8	including Medicare, Medicaid, Social Security Disability Insurance, and		
9	Social Security Supplemental Income; and		
10	(8) The estimated average annual total of direct and indirect		
11	costs for an individual with lupus is thirty-three thousand two hundred and		
12	twenty three dollars (\$33,223), and for people who have the most serious form		
13	of lupus, medical costs can greatly exceed this amount, causing a significant		
14	economic, emotional, and social burden to an entire family and society.		
15	(b) The purpose of Lupus Awareness Day is to promote public and health		
16	professional awareness among State and local health and human services		
17	officials, physicians, nurses, and other healthcare providers and increase		
18	knowledge concerning the causes and consequences of lupus, the importance of		
19	early diagnosis and appropriate management, and effective treatment and		
20	management strategies.		
21	(c) April 23 of each year shall be known as "Lupus Awareness Day".		
22	(d) Lupus Awareness Day shall not be a legal holiday but shall be a		
23	memorial day to be commemorated by the issuance of an appropriate		
24	proclamation by the Governor.		
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
