From time to time, the Secretary 15 of the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism may instruct the Chief 16 Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer on his or her books, and those of the 17 State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State, such amounts as determined by 18 the Secretary from the Arkansas Division of Heritage Special Fund Account to 19 a sub-fund within the Arkansas Cultural Institutions Trust Fund to make 20 grants for major capital improvement projects at Arkansas cultural 21 institutions. For any unobligated balances identified by the department, the 22 Secretary may instruct the Chief fiscal Officer of the State to transfer on 23 his or her books, and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the 24 State, the unobligated sub-fund balances in the Arkansas Cultural 25 Institutions Trust Fund to the Arkansas Division of Heritage Special Fund 26 Account. 27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2022 28 2023 through June 30, 2023 2024. 29 30 SECTION 33. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 31 32 OUACHITA RIVER COMMISSION. The Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism -33 Division of Heritage shall budget, allocate, and expend twenty thousand 34 dollars (\$20,000) in grants to the Ouachita River Commission from the

Grants/Aid-Ouachita River Commission line item in the Amendment 75 -

The provisions of this section shall be in affect only from July 1,  $\frac{2022}{2023}$  through June 30,  $\frac{2023}{2024}$ .

SECTION 34. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 35. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 36. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
