25	government official receives the request for permit.	
26	(2) If the local government official does not approve or deny an	
27	applicant's request for permit within sixty (60) days as required under	
28	subdivision (a)(1) of this section, the request for permit is automatically	
29	approved.	
30	(b) A local government official shall not impose additional	
31	requirements related to the request for permit if the request for permit is	
32	automatically approved under subdivision (a)(2) of this section.	
33	(c) The automatic approval of a permit under subdivision (a)(2) of	
34	this section shall not authorize the permit holder to violate a:
