15 TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING PROBATIONER
16 AND PAROLEE RESTRICTED DRIVING PERMITS.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-816(a), concerning probationer and
22 parolee restricted driving permits, is amended to read as follows:

23 (a)(1) If a person is on probation or parole, or is within ninety (90)
24 days of release on probation or parole, for an offense that did not involve
25 the operation of a motor vehicle and he or she has his or her license
26 suspended for a reason not listed under § 27-16-915(b)(2)(C), the person may
27 be eligible for a restricted driving permit under this section that permits
28 the holder to drive a motor vehicle directly to and directly home from:

29 (A) A place where he or she is employed;

30 (B) A place where he or she, or his or her minor child,
31 attends school;

32 (C) A scheduled meeting with his or her probation or
33 parole officer; or

34 (D) Any place, location, or meeting that the person's
35 probation or parole officer has directed the person on probation or parole to
36 travel to or attend.



1 (2) This section does not apply to a person with an expired
2 driver's license.

3 (3) A person is required to be qualified to operate a motor
4 vehicle under the laws of this state in order to be eligible to apply for a
5 restricted driving permit under this section.

7 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-16-816(b)(3), concerning probationer and
8 parolee restricted driving permits, is repealed. is amended to read as
9 follows:

10 ~~(3) The department may revoke a restricted driving permit under~~
11 ~~this section at any time and for any reason.~~

13 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-16-816(f), concerning probationer and
14 parolee restricted driving permits, is amended to read as follows:

15 (f)(1) A restricted driving permit issued under this section ~~expires~~
16 ~~on the date on which the person is released from probation or parole~~
17 ~~supervision~~ is valid for one (1) year from the date the restricted driving
18 permit was issued and may be renewed annually upon the submission of an
19 application by a probation or parole officer as required by subdivision
20 (b)(1) of this section.

21 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration may revoke a
22 restricted driving permit issued under this section at the request of a
23 probation or parole officer employed by the Division of Community Correction.
