32	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determine	ned by the General		
33	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas pr	ohibits the		
34	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period;	that the		
35	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to t	he operation of		
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the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

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1	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
2	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm
3	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
4	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
5	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
6	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
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
