3	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
4	20-76-118. Restoration or reimbursement for stolen Supplemental		
5	Nutrition Assistance Program Benefits.		
6	(a) The Department of Human Services shall restore or reimburse		
7	benefits under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program to a recipient		
8	whose benefits were stolen due to third-party fraud.		
9	(b) The department shall restore or reimburse benefits to a recipien		
10	under subsection (a) of this section only if:		
11	(1) Restoration or reimbursement is not available to the		
12	recipient by other means, including without limitation federal funds; and		
13	(2) The recipient had no part in the fraud.		
14	(c)(l) The Secretary of the Department of Human Services shall		
15	distribute funds from the Client Overpayment Fund in a manner that makes the		
16	best use of the funds available.		
17	(2) Full restoration of stolen benefits may not be available,		
18	depending on the availability of funding within the fund.
