3	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 6-65-
4	302, concerning the powers and duties of the Board of Trustees of Arkansas
5	Tech University, is amended to add additional subsections to codify special
6	language in appropriation acts to read as follows:
7	(c)(l) The board may reimburse tuition, fees, and other education-
8	related expenses of a current university faculty member who seeks additional
9	education levels that will benefit the university in meeting accreditation
10	and professional standards.
11	(2) Reimbursement under subdivision (c)(1) of this section shall
12	be authorized only when the reimbursement request submitted by the current
13	university faculty member has been documented by the university to meet
14	critical shortage instructional areas or is necessary for restructuring the
15	academic programs of the university.
16	
17	SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 6,
18	Chapter 65, Subchapter 3, is amended to add an additional section to codify
19	special language in appropriation acts to read as follows:
20	6-65-307. Arkansas Tech STEM Institute.
21	(a) Arkansas Tech STEM Institute shall be administered under the
22	direction of Arkansas Tech University.
23	(b) The institute shall utilize a multidisciplinary collaboration of
24	professionals to explore, develop, implement, and evaluate new and better
25	ways to integrate the teaching, study, and performance of the following for
26	academic, economic, and economic development purposes in the state:
27	(1) Business;
28	(2) Engineering;
29	(3) Emergency management;
30	(4) Agriculture;
31	(5) Health care;
32	(6) Technical programs; and
33	(7) Computer sciences.
34	(c) The priorities of the institute shall include without limitation:
35	(1) Economic development;
36	(2) Technology development; and

1	(3) Cyber-park development.
2	(d) The university shall make annual reports to the Legislative
3	Council or, if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget
4	Committee, on all matters regarding the following as they relate to the
5	institute:
6	(1) Funding;
7	(2) Existing programs offered by the institute; and
8	(3) Services offered through the institute.
9	
10	SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
11	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
12	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
13	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
14	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15	Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restriction
16	Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
17	applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
18	Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
19	disbursement of said funds.
20	
21	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
22	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
23	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
24	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
25	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
26	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
27	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
28	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
29	
30	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
31	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
32	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
33	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of
34	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
35	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
36	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm
