10	THE BOARDS OF TRUSTEES OF VARIOUS PUBLIC RETIREMENT

15	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE
16	MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARDS OF TRUSTEES OF
17	VARIOUS PUBLIC RETIREMENT SYSTEMS.
18

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21	
22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-4-104(b)(1), concerning the membership
23	of the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System,
24	is amended to read as follows:
25	(b)(1) The Auditor of State, the Treasurer of State a person
26	with a background in banking appointed by the Attorney General, and the
27	Secretary of the Department of Finance and Administration shall be ex officio
28	members;
29	
30	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-4-104(c), concerning the Board of
31	Trustees of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, is amended to
32	read as follows:
33	(c)(l) The term of office of $\frac{appointed}{appointed}$ trustees $\frac{appointed}{appointed}$ by the
34	Governor shall be six (6) years.
35	(2)(A) The Governor shall declare a vacancy on the board when a:
36	(i) Nonstate employee trustee leaves the employ of a

1	participating public employer;
2	(ii) State employee trustee leaves state employment;
3	(iii) Member who is a nonstate employee trustee
4	retires and there is another retired member of the system who is a nonstate
5	employee trustee on the board; and
6	(iv) Member who is a state employee trustee retires
7	and there is another retired member of the system who is a state employee
8	trustee on the board.
9	(B) A vacancy declared under subdivisions (c)(2)(A)(iii)
10	and (iv) of this section shall be for the seat of the newly retired trustee.
11	(C) The Governor shall appoint a state employee member or
12	a nonstate employee member to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the
13	unexpired term within thirty (30) days of the date on which the vacancy is
14	declared.
15	(3)(A) The term of office of the member appointed by the
16	Attorney General shall be six (6) years, and the member may be reappointed.
17	(B) A vacancy in the position appointed by the
18	Attorney General shall be filled by the Attorney General within thirty (30)
19	days of the date on which the vacancy is declared.
20	
21	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-5-104(b), concerning the membership of
22	the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement
23	System, is amended to read as follows:
24	(b)(1) The board shall consist of seven (7) members:
25	(A) The Director of State Highways and Transportation;
26	(B) The Treasurer of State A person with a background in
27	banking appointed by the Attorney General;
28	(C) The Secretary of the Department of Finance and
29	Administration;
30	(D) The Chief Engineer of the Arkansas Department of
31	Transportation;
32	(E) A retiree from the Arkansas State Highway and
33	Transportation Department or the Arkansas Department of Transportation; and
34	(F) Two (2) regularly qualified members of the system.
35	(2) The board shall cause an election to be held by letter

1	membership, for the purpose of electing two (2) employee members and one (1)
2	retiree member who shall serve for two (2) years.
3	(3) In case of a vacancy of any employee member of the board,
4	the board shall fill the vacancy until the next regular election, when the
5	vacancy shall be filled by the election procedure specified in subdivision
6	(b)(2) of this section.
7	(4)(A) The term of office of the member appointed by the
8	Attorney General shall be six (6) years, and the member may be reappointed.
9	(B) A vacancy in the position appointed by the Attorney
10	General shall be filled by the Attorney General.
11	
12	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 24-7-301(1), concerning the membership of
13	the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, is amended
14	to read as follows:
15	(1) The Bank Commissioner, the Treasurer of State a person with
16	a background in banking appointed by the Attorney General, the Auditor of
17	State, and the Commissioner of Elementary and Secondary Education shall be ex
18	officio trustees;
19	
20	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 24-7-302, concerning the term of office and
21	vacancies for members of the Board of the Arkansas Teachers Retirement
22	System, is amended to add a new subsection to read as follows:
23	(d)(1) The term of office of the member appointed by the Attorney
24	General shall be six (6) years, and the member may be reappointed.
25	(2) A vacancy in the position appointed by the Attorney
26	General shall be filled by the Attorney General
27
