12	(i) A debt of the insured or beneficiary secured by		
13	a pledge of the insurance policy or the proceeds of the insurance policy; or		
14	(ii) A child support lien or levy.		
15	(D) For purposes of the limitation on the personal		
16	property exemption stated in Arkansas Constitution, Article 9, § 2, "persona		
17	property" does not include life insurance proceeds that are payable to:		
18	(i) A beneficiary other than the insured, including		
19	without limitation a charitable organization; or		
20	(ii) The spouse, children, or dependents of the
