25	in the Arkansas Division of the Future Farmers of America and an Arkansas 4-H
26	Foundation, Incorporated program.
27	(d) The curriculum for the elementary agricultural education program
28	shall be fact-based instruction that shall:
29	(1) Include without limitation equal portions of each of the
30	three (3) components of school-based agricultural education, as specified
31	under subsection (c) of this section;
32	(2) Provide grade-appropriate, collaborative learning
33	experiences through:
34	(A) Instruction and inquiry;
35	(B) Experimental learning activities; and
