Reformation. 9 Upon the petition of an interested person, a court shall reform a 10 disposition in the manner that most closely approximates the transferor's 11 manifested plan of distribution and is within the 90 years 1,000 years 12 allowed by § 18-3-101(a)(2), § 18-3-101(b)(2), or § 18-3-101(c)(2) if: 13 (1) a nonvested property interest or a power of appointment 14 becomes invalid under § 18-3-101; 15 (2) a class gift is not but might become invalid under § 18-3-16 101 and the time has arrived when the share of any class member is to take 17 effect in possession or enjoyment; or 18 (3) a nonvested property interest that is not validated by § 18-19 3-101(a)(1) can vest but not within 90 years 1,000 years after its creation. 20 21 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 18-3-105 is amended to read as follows: 22 18-3-105. Prospective application. 23 (a) Except as extended by subsection (b) of this section, this chapter 24 applies to a nonvested property interest or a power of appointment that is 25 created on or after March 9, 2007 the effective date of this act. For 26 purposes of this section, a nonvested property interest or a power of 27 appointment created by the exercise of a power of appointment is created when 28 the power is irrevocably exercised or when a revocable exercise becomes 29 irrevocable. 30 (b) If a nonvested property interest or a power of appointment was created before March 9, 2007 the effective date of this act, and is 31 32 determined in a judicial proceeding, commenced on or after March 9, 2007 the 33 effective date of this act, to violate this State's rule against perpetuities 34 as that rule existed before March 9, 2007 the effective date of this act, a 35 court upon the petition of an interested person may reform the disposition in 36 the manner that most closely approximates the transferor's manifested plan of
