SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-24-305(a), concerning the validity of a special license plate, is amended to read as follows: (a) A special license plate issued under this subchapter shall be valid for as long as the motor vehicle to which the plate is attached is: (1) Owned or leased by the county, city, incorporated town, county quorum court member, or other public entity; and (2) Used exclusively in the business of the county, city, incorporated town, or other public entity.
