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26	SECTION 1. Arka	nnsas Code § 27-72-302(b), concern	ing the establishment
27	of a system of state a	aid roads in each county of the sta	ate, is amended to
28	read as follows:		
29	(b) There is se	et up for designation by cooperativ	ve action of the state
30	and counties a state a	aid system of roads, as classified	and defined in this
31	subchapter, which syst	em shall be designated by the seve	eral county judges of
32	their respective count	ies with the consent and approval	of the state aid
33	engineer and the State Highway Commission to a total mileage not in excess of

1	federal-aid secondary road system. The system will periodically be expanded		
2	in one thousand-mile increments after the initial five thousand-mile system

5	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-72-310(b), concerning contracts for work		
6	to be performed on state aid roads, is amended to read as follows:		
7	(b) The county judge of any county is authorized to submit bids for		
8	work to be performed on state aid roads under the provisions of this		
9	subchapter, and nothing contained herein shall be construed to limit or		
10	restrict the right of a county judge to submit bids for work to be performed		
11	by county forces so long as the bids are in accordance with procedures		
12	prescribed in § 27-67-206, and the aggregate cost thereof does not exceed $\frac{1}{2}$		
13	hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

15	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-72-312(b) and (c), concerning the use of		
16	the State Aid Road Fund, are amended to read as follows:		
17	(b) Not more than twenty-five percent (25%) of a \underline{A} county's allotment		
18	from the fund $\frac{1}{2}$ may be used for the purposes of resealing, $\frac{1}{2}$		
19	surfacing, and other methods of pavement preservation.		
20	(c) No Other than funds spent on pavement preservation projects under		
21	subsection (b) of this section, funds shall \underline{not} be spent $\underline{hereunder}$ on \underline{any} \underline{a}		
22	project which shall that does not culminate directly in a paved hard-surfaced		
23	road.		
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
