3	in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 96 of 2022, for asphalt resurfacing,
4	replacement of damaged sidewalks and curbs, addition of lighting to unlit or
5	dark areas, an upgrade of the irrigation system, and landscaping and
6	plantings for the North Entry Promenade I & II of the State Capitol Grounds,
7	in a sum not to exceed\$538,112.
8	(F) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided
9	in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 96 of 2022, for drains and storm water system
10	renovations of the State Capitol Grounds, in a sum not to exceed\$483,000.
11	(G) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided
12	in Item (G) of Section 1 of Act 96 of 2022, for interior plumbing and sump
13	pump replacement for the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed
14	\$108,393.
15	(H) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided
16	in Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 96 of 2022, for electrical panel replacement
17	in the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed\$212,980.
18	(I) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided
19	in Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 96 of 2022, for expenses for State Capitol
20	as-built drawings, in a sum not to exceed\$250,000.
21	(J) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided
22	in Item (J) of Section 1 of Act 96 of 2022, for "Green" Initiatives for the
23	State Capitol building, facilities and grounds including ventilation system
24	cleaning, energy efficiency improvements and assessment, analysis and
25	consulting services, recycling programs and/or related construction,
26	renovation and equipping of and/or conversion to or purchase of Compressed
27	Natural Gas vehicles and equipment including installation of a refueling
28	station, in a sum not to exceed\$1,500,000.
29	(K) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided
30	in Item (K) of Section 1 of Act 96 of 2022, for stone restoration, cleaning
31	and repointing on the East Side of the State Capitol building, in a sum not
32	to exceed\$3,500,000.
33	(L) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided
34	in Item (L) of Section 1 of Act 96 of 2022, for Business and Commercial
35	Services System Update, in a sum not to exceed\$4,000,000.

- SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Secretary of State the following:
- 5 (A) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided 6 in Section 24 of Act 196 of 2022, for the acquisition, management, 7 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, 8 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$1,126,271.

SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
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3	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
4	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
5	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
6	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of		
7	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in		
8	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the		
9	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm		
10	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental		
11	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
12	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health		
13	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.		
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
