## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
10 CORRECTIONS - DIVISION OF CORRECTION; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS  
15 - DIVISION OF CORRECTION REAPPROPRIATION.  
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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21 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is  
22 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the  
23 Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Corrections -  
24 Division of Correction the following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
26 in Section 19 of Act 203 of 2022, for costs associated with prison expansion,  
27 in a sum not to exceed .....\$75,000,000.

28 (B) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
29 in Item (O) of Section 2 of Act 104 of 2022, for personal services and  
30 operating expenses of the Division of Correction - Female Work Release - Pine  
31 Bluff, in a sum not to exceed .....\$867,610.

32 (C) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
33 in Item (P) of Section 2 of Act 104 of 2022, for operating expenses of the  
34 Tucker Unit, in a sum not to exceed .....\$74,627.

35 (D) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
36 in Item (Q) of Section 2 of Act 104 of 2022, for maintenance, replacement,



1 repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement  
2 and upgrade of existing facilities of the Division of Correction, in a sum  
3 not to exceed .....\$1,558,532.

4 (E) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
5 in Item (T) of Section 2 of Act 104 of 2022, for construction of two armories  
6 at the Varner and Tucker units, in a sum not to exceed .....\$4,942.

7 (F) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
8 in Item (U) of Section 2 of Act 104 of 2022, for replacement of the existing  
9 Water Treatment Plant at the Tucker Unit, in a sum not to exceed ...\$939,891.

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11 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS INDUSTRY PROJECTS - CASH. There  
12 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from  
13 the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief  
14 Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Corrections - Division of  
15 Correction the following:

16 (A) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
17 in Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 104 of 2022, for construction, renovation and  
18 major maintenance of facilities and Central Warehouse of the Division of  
19 Correction, in a sum not to exceed .....\$5,000,000.

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21 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS INDUSTRY PROJECTS. There is  
22 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the  
23 Division of Correction Prison Industry Fund, for the Department of  
24 Corrections - Division of Correction the following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
26 in Item (A) of Section 5 of Act 104 of 2022, for maintenance, replacement,  
27 repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement  
28 and upgrade of the Department of Corrections - Various Industry Projects, in  
29 a sum not to exceed .....\$976,645.

30 (B) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
31 in Item (B) of Section 5 of Act 104 of 2022, for maintenance, replacement,  
32 repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement  
33 and upgrade of the Division of Correction - Various Industry Projects, in a  
34 sum not to exceed .....\$6,312.

35 (C) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
36 in Item (C) of Section 5 of Act 104 of 2022, for various industry projects

1 including storage at the Wrightsville Unit near the industry buildings, in a  
2 sum not to exceed .....\$150,000.

3 (D) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
4 in Item (D) of Section 5 of Act 104 of 2022, for various industry projects  
5 for maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping,  
6 renovation, purchase, improvement and upgrade of the Division of Correction,  
7 in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

8 (E) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
9 in Item (E) of Section 5 of Act 104 of 2022, for construction, renovation and  
10 major maintenance of facilities and Central Warehouse, in a sum not to exceed  
11 .....\$5,000,000.

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13 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS FARM PROJECTS. There is hereby  
14 appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the  
15 Division of Correction Farm Fund, for the Department of Corrections -  
16 Division of Correction the following:

17 (A) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
18 in Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 104 of 2022, for maintenance, replacement,  
19 repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement  
20 and upgrade of the Department of Corrections - Various Farm Projects, in a  
21 sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

22 (B) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
23 in Item (B) of Section 6 of Act 104 of 2022, for maintenance, replacement,  
24 repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement  
25 and upgrade of the Division of Correction - Various Farm Projects, in a sum  
26 not to exceed .....\$140,534.

27 (C) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
28 in Item (E) of Section 6 of Act 104 of 2022, for renovation of the current  
29 dairy facility and replacement of equipment, in a sum not to exceed  
30 .....\$2,799,800.

31 (D) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
32 in Item (F) of Section 6 of Act 104 of 2022, for construction of grain  
33 storage bins at Cummins, Tucker and East Arkansas Units, in a sum not to  
34 exceed .....\$2,430,250.

35 (E) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
36 in Item (G) of Section 6 of Act 104 of 2022, for maintenance and repair to

1 upgrade the existing feed mill at the Cummins Unit, in a sum not to exceed  
2 .....\$889,750.

3 (F) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
4 in Item (H) of Section 6 of Act 104 of 2022, for Irrigation Project at  
5 Tucker/Cummins, in a sum not to exceed .....\$110,000.

6 (G) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
7 in Item (I) of Section 6 of Act 104 of 2022, for various farm projects for  
8 maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping,  
9 renovation, purchase, improvement and upgrade of the Division of Correction,  
10 in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

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12 SECTION 5. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
13 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
14 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
15 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
16 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
17 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
18 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
19 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
20 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
21 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
22 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
23 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

24 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
25 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
26 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
27 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
28 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
29 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
30 otherwise by law.

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32 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
33 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
34 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
35 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
36 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
2 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
3 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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5 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
6 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
7 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
8 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of  
9 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
10 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
11 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm  
12 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
13 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
14 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
15 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.

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
