28	election materials at each additional early voting polling site shall be			
29	stored in a secure location in the county courthouse or in a secure location			
30	as determined by the county board of election commissioners immediately after			
31	the close of the additional polling sites each day that early voting is			
32	conducted there.

13	(a) Deposited in a separate ballot box secured		
14	with a numbered seal for each polling location that is utilized; and		
15	(b) Secured at the central location used to		
16	secure all other ballots before or contemporaneously with the transportation		
17	of the other voting equipment between early voting locations.
