  license under § 27-16-801, an applicant or licensee providing an individual

  tax identification number as provided under this section shall pay an

  additional fee in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00).

  8 identification number under subdivision (a)(1)(C) of this section, the
  9 driver's license shall be issued for a period not to exceed four (4) years.

(d) A licensee who was previously issued a driver's license after

- having provided proof of filing a state tax return and an individual taxpayer
  identification number under subsection (a) of this section may be eligible to
  have his or her driver's license renewed at the discretion of the Secretary
  of the Department of Finance and Administration, upon providing proof of
  filing a state tax return for each year between the date of issuance of the
  driver's license and the year prior to the expiration of the driver's
  - (e) At least quarterly, the Office of Motor Vehicle shall transmit to the Secretary of State identifying information, including without limitation the name, date of birth, residential address, and mailing address of an applicant issued a driver's license under this section to be used to verify the accuracy of the voter registration roll.
  - (f) The Department of Finance and Administration shall adopt rules necessary for the administration of this section.

(a) The General Assembly finds that:

- 29 (1) Currently, driver's licenses and identification cards are 30 valid for a standard statutory period of time;
- 31 (2) An applicant for the issuance or renewal of a driver's
  32 license or an identification card who is not a citizen of the United States
  33 may obtain a driver's license or an identification card that is valid for a
  34 period that exceeds his or her authorization to be lawfully present in the
  35 United States;
- 36 (3) The United States Government, specifically United States

Immigration and Customs Enforcement, an agency of the United States Department of Homeland Security, has authority over immigration matters and makes determinations on the length of time that a person who is not a citizen of the United States can is permitted to remain in the United States; and (4) A driver's license or identification card that is valid for a period that exceeds the time prescribed by United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, an agency of the United States Department of Homeland Security, can be used to circumvent federal law and cause confusion on the status of the individual to whom it is issued. The purpose of \$\$ 27-16-1111 and \$ 27-16-1112 is to ensure that driver's licenses and identification cards issued by the state are not used to circumvent federal immigration laws or federal authority on immigration matters by preventing an applicant for the issuance or renewal of a driver's license or an identification card from obtaining an identity document issued by the state that is valid for a period that exceeds the applicant's authorization to be lawfully present in the United States.
