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1 (2) The driver's license issued under subsection (a)(1) of this 2 section shall clearly display on its face and shall be highlighted "Not valid 3 for voter identification". 4 (b) In addition to the cost of the issuance or renewal of a driver's 5 license under § 27-16-801, an applicant or licensee providing an individual 6 tax identification number as provided under this section shall pay an 7 additional fee in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00). 8 (c) If the applicant or licensee provides an individual taxpayer 9 identification number under subdivision (a)(1)(C) of this section, the 10 driver's license shall be issued for a period not to exceed four (4) years. 11 (d) A licensee who was previously issued a driver's license after 12 having provided proof of filing a state tax return and an individual taxpayer identification number under subsection (a) of this section may be eligible to 13 have his or her driver's license renewed at the discretion of the Secretary 14 15 of the Department of Finance and Administration, upon providing proof of filing a state tax return for each year between the date of issuance of the 16 17 driver's license and the year prior to the expiration of the driver's 18 license. 19 (e) At least quarterly, the Office of Driver Services shall transmit 20 to the Secretary of State identifying information, including without limitation the name, date of birth, residential address, and mailing address 21 22 of an applicant issued a driver's license under this section to be used to 23 verify the accuracy of the voter registration roll. (f) The Department of Finance and Administration shall adopt rules 24 25 necessary for the administration of this section. 26 27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-16-1110 is amended to read as follows: 27-16-1110. Findings and purpose of \S 27-16-1111 and \S 27-16-1112. 28 29 (a) The General Assembly finds that: (1) Currently, driver's licenses and identification cards are 30 31 valid for a standard statutory period of time; 32 (2) An applicant for the issuance or renewal of a driver's 33 license or an identification card who is not a citizen of the United States may obtain a driver's license or an identification card that is valid for a 34 35 period that exceeds his or her authorization to be lawfully present in the 36 United States;

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1	(3) The United States Government, specifically United States
2	Immigration and Customs Enforcement, an agency of the United States
3	Department of Homeland Security, has authority over immigration matters and
4	makes determinations on the length of time that a person who is not a citizen
5	of the United States ean is permitted to remain in the United States; and
6	(4) A driver's license or identification card that is valid for
7	a period that exceeds the time prescribed by United States Immigration and
8	Customs Enforcement, an agency of the United States Department of Homeland
9	Security, can be used to circumvent federal law and cause confusion on the
10	status of the individual to whom it is issued.
11	(b) The purpose of \S 27-16-1111 and \S 27-16-1112 is to ensure that
12	driver's licenses and identification cards issued by the state are not used
13	to circumvent federal immigration laws or federal authority on immigration
14	matters by preventing an applicant for the issuance or renewal of $\frac{a\ driver's}{a\ driver's}$
15	$\frac{1}{1}$ likewise or $\frac{1}{2}$ identification card from obtaining an identity document issued
16	by the state that is valid for a period that exceeds the applicant's
17	authorization to be lawfully present in the United States.
