2	(2) Who has been forced to leave his or her home; or		
3	(3) Whose parents have left the area and left the youth behind.		
4	(b) An unaccompanied homeless youth may become certified if he or she		
5	<u>is:</u>		
6	(1) Found by a school district's liaison for homeless children		
7	and youths to be an unaccompanied homeless youth eligible for services under		
8	the federal McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. § 11432 et		
9	seq., as existing on January 1, 2023; or		
10	(2) Believed to qualify as an unaccompanied homeless youth, as		
11	defined in the federal McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. §		
12	11432 et seq., as existing on January 1, 2023, by:		
13	(A) The director of an emergency shelter program funded by		
14	the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, or the		
15	designee of the director of an emergency shelter program funded by the United		
16	States Department of Housing and Urban Development;		
17	(B) The director of a runaway or homeless youth basic		
18	center or transitional living program funded by the United States Department		
19	of Health and Human Services, or the director's designee; or		
20	(C) A continuum of care lead agency, or its designee.		
21	(c)(1) The Department of Human Services shall develop a standardized		
22	form that must be used by the entities specified in subsection (b) of this

12	copies, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:		
13	(c) However, a certified copy of his or her birth certificate shall be		
14	furnished without cost to:		
15	(1) A youth in foster care who reaches eighteen (18) years of		
16	age or before leaving foster care; or		
17	(2) A certified unaccompanied homeless youth under § 9-25-106.		
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19	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-16-801, concerning the issuance of a		
20	driver's license, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as		
21	follows:		
22	(i) The Office of Driver Services shall not charge a fee for the		
23	issuance of a driver's license under subsection (a) of this section or any		
24	other costs incidental to licensure under this section for an eligible		
25	applicant in foster care or a certified unaccompanied homeless youth under §		
26	<u>9-25-106.</u>

28	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 27-16-805(a), concerning the issuance of an		
29	identification card, is amended to read as follows:		
30	(a)(1) The Office of Driver Services may issue an identification card		
31	to Arkansas residents five (5) years of age or older who are not licensed		
32	drivers.		
33	(2) $\underline{(A)}$ The fee for the identification card is five dollars		
34	(\$5.00).		
35	(B) However, the office shall not charge a fee for the		
36	issuance of an identification card to an eligible applicant who is in foster		

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1	care or is a certified unaccompanied homeless youth under § 9-25-106.		
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3	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 27-18-106(a), concerning fees paid for		
4	driver education, is amended to read as follows:		
5	(a)(1) For <del>any of</del> the purposes set out in § 27-18-101, the Arkansas		
6	State Police Commission is authorized to charge a fee of five dollars (\$5.00		
7	for any student of the driver education course in the following amounts:		
8	(A) Five dollars (\$5.00) for a student of:		
9	(i) An accredited high school;		
10	(B) (ii) A state or privately supported college,		
11	university, or junior college; and or		
12	$\frac{(C)}{(iii)}$ Any A vocational-technical training school		
13	engaging in the driver education course-; and		
14	(2)(B) The commission is further authorized to charge a fee of		
15	ten Ten dollars (\$10.00) for any other person engaging in the driver

20	purpose and intent of this chapter to provide driver education for the		
21	citizens of Arkansas.		
22	(3) The commission shall waive the fee authorized by this		
23	section for a child in foster care or an unaccompanied homeless youth		
24	certified under § 9-25-106.
