The Clerk of the State Claims 5 Commission shall initiate the appropriate transfers as may be required and as 6 approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

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SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLAIMS FROM CASH FUNDS. In the event that any claim authorized herein is determined to be a valid claim against the State and the claim is to be paid from funds not in the State Treasury, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall notify the agency against which the claim is to be charged of the amount of Upon receipt of such notification, the state agency shall such claims. forth-with deliver a check to the Clerk of the State Claims Commission who shall deposit the same as a nonrevenue receipt into the Miscellaneous Revolving Fund from which he shall disburse the amount of the claim to the claimant.

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20 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 22 EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION CLAIMS. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission 23 shall not distribute any warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act 24 for awards made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission for employment 25 compensation claims. Upon the award by the State Claims Commission of an 26 employment compensation claim, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall 27 notify the affected state agency and the Department of Finance and 28 Administration - Office of Personnel Management of such amounts that are due 29 and payable. The affected state agency shall then process the award through 30 the State Mechanized Payroll System.

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SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

1 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 2 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 3 4 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 5 6 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 7 8 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 9 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 10 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 11 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 12 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 13 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 14 15 SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 16 General Assembly, that payees listed in this Act may be entitled to the sums 17 appropriated and transferred to herein, and that they have been deprived of 18 the use of these funds for a long period of time, and that further delay in 19 paying these just debts of the state would do harm to the reputation of the 20 State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, 21 22 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date 23 of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 24 25 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 26 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 27 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 28 the veto. 29 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
