3	(a)(l) A violation of this subchapter is punishable by a fine of not		
4	less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred fifty		
5	dollars (\$250) for the first offense.		
6	(2) Each subsequent violation of this subchapter is punishable		
7	by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than five hundred		
8	dollars (\$500).		
9	(b) $\underline{(1)}$ If a person pleads guilty or nolo contendere to a violation of		
10	this subchapter or the finder of fact determines that the person was involved		
11	in a collision or accident while in violation of this subchapter, a court
