21	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE.	
22	(a) As used in this section, "spaceport" means an installati	on and
23	related facilities utilized for the takeoff, landing, retrieval, se	rvicing,
24	and monitoring of vehicles capable of entering space.	
25	(b) The Arkansas Economic Development Commission shall condu	ıct a study
26	to determine the feasibility of developing a spaceport in Arkansas.	<u>-</u>
27	(c) The feasibility study shall include an assessment of:	
28	(1) The spaceport recommendations included in the fina	ıl report

15	(c) The feasibility study shall be completed no later than January 1

17	(d) After completion of the feasibility study, the commission shall		
18	submit a feasibility report that includes the commission's recommendations		
19	concerning the development of a spaceport in Arkansas to the:		
20	(A) Governor;		
21	(B) Arkansas Department of Transportation; and
