14	6-60-119. Overdose rescue kit — Required.		
15	(a) The Division of Higher Education shall consult and collaborate		
16	with the Department of Health to ensure each campus of each institution in		
17	the State of Arkansas has an overdose rescue kit on an affixed wall mount		
18	that is clearly visible and labeled with the words "Overdose Rescue Kit -		
19	Narcan Nasal Spray" or other language approved by the division.		
20	(b) An overdose rescue kit required under subsection (a) of this		
21	section shall:		
22	(1) Be visually free of advertisements;		
23	(2) Be located where it is readily available for public use; and		
24	(3) Include without limitation:		
25	(A) Narcan;		
26	(B) Naloxone; or		
27	(C) Another medication approved by the Department of		
28	Health and the United States Food and Drug Administration that, when		
29	administered, negates or neutralizes, in whole or in part, the		
30	pharmacological effects of an opioid in the human body.		
31	(c) The location of each overdose rescue kit required under subsection		
32	(a) of this section shall be registered with the campus police of the		
33	institution.		
34	(d) As used in this section, "institution" means a state-supported		
35	two-year or four-year institution of higher education located in the State of		
36	Arkansas.
