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6	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-18-220, concerning student absences
7	granted for participation in National FFA Organization, The Arkansas Family,
8	Career and Community Leaders of America, Inc., and 4-H programs, is amended
9	to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
10	(d)(1) A student who is absent from the school district in which he or
11	she is enrolled shall be granted an excused absence by the public school
12	district if the reason for the student's absence is to participate in 4-H
13	activities or programs that are scheduled and approved by a county extension
14	agent, 4-H educator, or other appropriate authority.
15	(2) The maximum number of excused absences granted under
16	subdivision (d)(1) of this section shall be established by each public school
17	district board of directors in the public school district's student
18	attendance policy.
19	(3) A 4-H county extension agent, 4-H educator, or other
20	appropriate entity associated with the 4-H activity or program shall provide
21	to a public school principal or other designated official upon request
22	documentation as proof of a student's participation in an activity or program
23	scheduled and approved by the 4-H program.
24	(4) A student who is granted an absence under subdivision (d)(1)
25	of this section shall:
26	(A) Be given the opportunity to complete any schoolwork
27	that was missed while the student was absent; and
28	(B) Not have his or her grades adversely affected due to
29	his or her:
30	(i) Absence from a class due to his or her
31	participation in a 4-H activity or a program; or
32	(ii) Participation in a 4-H activity or a program.
33	(5) A public school principal or his or her designee shall not
34	grant a student an excused absence under subdivision (d)(1) of this section
35	if the student's participation in a 4-H activity or a program occurs during a
36	period of time:

1	(A) Scheduled by the State Board of Education during which
2	statewide student assessments are administered; or
3	(B) For which the student has been disciplined, suspended,
4	or expelled, if the terms of the discipline, suspension, or expulsion would
5	preclude the student from participating in a school-sponsored educational
6	field trip or extracurricular activity.
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
