6	tax records and other reports, is amended to read as follows:		
7	(d) $\underline{(1)}$ The Secretary of State may grant an extension of time not to		
8	exceed six (6) months for the filing of the tax records and other reports		
9	required by this section upon the charitable organization's filing a notice		
10	that states the need for an extension.		
11	(2) The Secretary of State may grant a charitable organization		
12	an additional three (3) months extension of time under subdivision (d)(1) of
