25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-709 is amended to read as follows:
28	6-17-709. Professional development schedule.
29	(a) Beginning with the 2013-2014 school year, a school district or an
30	open-enrollment public charter school shall make available to the appropriate
31	licensed personnel the following professional development:
32	(1) In the 2013-2014 school year and every fourth fifth school
33	year thereafter, the professional development for mandated reporters and
34	licensed elementary and secondary public school personnel required under § 6-
35	61-133;
36	(2)(A) In the 2014-2015 Beginning with the 2023-2024 school year

- 1 and every fourth school year thereafter, the family and community engagement
- 2 professional development under § 6-15-1703 <u>shall be taken by licensed</u>
- 3 personnel at least one (1) time.
- 4 (B) If the appropriate licensed personnel has completed
- 5 the family and community engagement professional development required under
- 6 subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section at least one (1) time before the 2023-
- 7 <u>2024 school year, he or she shall not be required to complete the family and</u>
- 8 <u>community engagement professional development again;</u>

3	required under subdivision (e)(3)(A) of this section in a separate educator
4	preparation program or in another state and who has provided the division
5	with verification of the obtainment of the training shall not be subject to
6	the additional training required under subdivision (e)(3)(A) of this section.
7	(B)(C) For a teaching license issued under the state's
8	reciprocity provisions to an out-of-state teacher, the Division of Elementary
9	and Secondary Education shall issue a provisional license until the licensee
10	obtains the professional development identified in subdivision (e)(3)(A) of
11	this section.

13	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § $6-17-2402(1)$ (A), concerning the definition
14	of a "basic contract" under the Teacher Compensation Program of 2003, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	(1)(A)(i) "Basic contract" means a teacher employment contract
17	for one hundred ninety (190) days that includes no less than six (6) days of
18	professional development, except as provided under subdivision (1)(B) of this
19	section for teachers employed in a Civilian Student Training Program or the
20	Arkansas National Guard Youth Challenge Program.
21	(ii) A public school district shall not require more
22	than four (4) days of professional development in addition to the six (6)
23	days of professional development included in a basic contract under
24	subdivision (1)(A)(i) of this section.
