8	special certificate issued under the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, 29		
9	U.S.C. § 201 et seq., as existing on January 1, 2023.		
10	(b) As long as a Section 14(c) certificate is issued by the United		
11	States Department of Labor, an organization that holds a Section 14(c)		
12	certificate is recognized as legal to employ individuals with disabilities		
13	and is protected by this state.
