1	(f) If the Office of Driver Services issues a commercial learner's		
2	permit to an applicant, the applicant may take the commercial driver license		
3	skills test no earlier than fourteen (14) calendar days following the date of		
4	issuance of the commercial learner's permit.

6	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
7	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that agriculture makes up		
8	approximately one-third $(1/3)$ of the state's gross domestic product; that the		
9	State of Arkansas is experiencing labor shortages in all industries but		
10	specifically in transportation and agriculture; that the waiting periods		
11	required by law for a driver's license applicant to complete the driver's		
12	examination are arbitrary time periods that serve no specific purpose; that		
13	the agricultural planting season begins later this month and the agricultural		
14	labor force is in need of licensed drivers; and that migrant workers arriving		
15	<u>in Arkansas to join the agricultural labor force need to be able to drive in</u>		
16	order to provide their labor services as quickly as possible. Therefore, an		
17	emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for		
18	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become		
19	effective on:		
20	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
21	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
22	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
23	<u>bill; or</u>		
24	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
25	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
