2	after July 1, 1987, through December 31, 1988, the maximum weekly benefits		
3	payable shall be one hundred eighty-nine dollars (\$189);		
4	(2) For disability or death due to an injury occurring on and		
5	after January 1, 1989, through December 31, 1989, the maximum weekly benefits		
6	payable shall be sixty-six and two-thirds percent (66%%) of the state averag		
7	weekly wage;
