3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, Subchapter 1, is amended		
4	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
5	6-60-119. Automated external defibrillators required — Automated		
6	external defibrillator and cardiopulmonary resuscitation programs.		
7	(a) The Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board, in collaboration		
8	with all public university and community college presidents and chancellors		
9	or their designees, shall develop and adopt rules to require:		
10	(A) An automated external defibrillator to be placed in		
11	appropriate locations across each institution of higher education campus as		
12	determined by rule;		
13	(B) Appropriate personnel be adequately trained on an		
14	ongoing basis; and		
15	(C) Each institution of higher education-sponsored		
16	sporting event have an automated external defibrillator at the institution of		
17	higher education-sponsored sporting event.		
18	(b) The board, after consultation with the Department of Health, shall		
19	develop rules based on guidelines for automated external defibrillator and		
20	cardiopulmonary resuscitation training that incorporates at least the		
21	<u>following:</u>		
22	(1) Healthcare provider oversight, including planning and review		
23	of the selection, placement, and maintenance of automated external		
24	defibrillators;		
25	(2) Appropriate training of anticipated rescuers in the use of		
26	the automated external defibrillator and in cardiopulmonary resuscitation;		
27	(3) Testing of psychomotor skills based on the American Heart		
28	Association scientific guidelines, standards, and recommendations for the use		
29	of the automated external defibrillator, as they existed on January 1, 2023,		
30	and for providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation as published by the American		
31	Heart Association or the American Red Cross as they existed on January 1,		
32	2023, or equivalent course materials;		
33	(4) Coordination with the emergency medical services system; and		
34	(5) An ongoing quality improvement program to monitor training		
35	and evaluate response with each use of the automated external defibrillator.		
36	(c) Automated external defibrillator and cardiopulmonary resuscitation		

1	training shall count fully toward the existing professional development	<u>t</u>
2	requirements for personnel.	
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
