  - (8) Property that accumulates after a complaint for divorce is filed in an interest-bearing account that was in the name of one (1) spouse only before either spouse files a complaint for divorce, including without limitation property that accumulates in a pension fund, retirement account, or investment account of one (1) spouse after the complaint for divorce has been filed.

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
