

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1 enrolled in good standing in the College of Medicine of the University of 2 Arkansas for Medical Sciences in studies leading to the degree of Doctor of 3 Medicine; 4 (2) A student who has been accepted for admission to or is 5 enrolled in good standing in an educational program for physician assistants 6 accredited by the Accreditation Review Commission on Education for the 7 Physician Assistant, Inc. or its successor, as required for licensing 8 purposes under § 17-105-101 et seq.; or 9 (3) A student who has been accepted for admission to or is 10 enrolled in good standing in a regionally accredited United States college or university with a program in human nutrition, food and nutrition, dietetics, 11 12 or food systems management, as required for licensing purposes under § 17-87-13 301 et seq. 14 (b) A graduate of the College of Medicine of the University of 15 Arkansas for Medical Sciences or any accredited medical school in the United 16 States may apply for the community match income incentive program under this 17 subchapter on forms prescribed by the board so long as the applicant 18 satisfies the criteria set forth in § 6-81-715. 19 20 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-81-706 is amended to read as follows: 21 6-81-706. Medical students Applicants - Eligibility for initial and 22 renewal loans. 23 The Arkansas Rural Medically Underserved Population Medical (a) 24 Practice Student Loan and Scholarship Board may make rural medically 25 underserved population medical practice loans to the an applicant, each rural 26 medically underserved population medical practice loan being expressly made 27 subject to the provisions of § 6-81-708(c) and § 6-81-710, if it finds that: 28 (1) The applicant is a bona fide resident of Arkansas; 29 (2) The applicant has been accepted for admission to or is enrolled in good standing in the College of Medicine of the University of 30 31 Arkansas for Medical Sciences in studies leading to the degree of Doctor of 32 Medicine is a student who has been accepted for admission to or is enrolled 33 in good standing in: 34 (A) The College of Medicine of the University of Arkansas 35 for Medical Sciences in studies leading to the degree of Doctor of Medicine; 36 (B) An educational program for physician assistants

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1 located in the State of Arkansas and accredited by the Accreditation Review 2 Commission on Education for the Physician Assistant, Inc. or its successor, 3 as required for licensing purposes under § 17-105-101 et seq.; or 4 (C) A regionally accredited United States college or 5 university located in the State of Arkansas with a program in human 6 nutrition, food and nutrition, dietetics, or food systems management, as 7 required for licensing purposes under § 17-87-301 et seq.; 8 (3) The applicant is enrolled in a medically underserved and 9 rural practice curriculum, as applicable to the college or educational 10 program for which an applicant has been accepted for admission or in which an 11 applicant is enrolled in good standing; 12 (4) The applicant needs financial assistance to complete his or her medical studies; 13 14 (5) The applicant desires to practice medicine in an eligible 15 qualified rural a community with a medically underserved population; and 16 (6) The applicant is a person of good moral character and one 17 who has the talent and capacity to profit by medical studies. 18 (b) Subject to the availability of funds, an initial rural medically 19 underserved population medical practice loan for one (1) academic year shall 20 be renewable annually for the number of years required to complete studies leading to the Doctor of Medicine a degree necessary for an eligible 21 22 profession under this subchapter or for additional amounts, not to exceed the 23 maximum amounts specified in § 6-81-707, but all subsequent rural medically 24 underserved population medical practice loans shall be granted only upon 25 application by the recipient and a finding by the board that: 26 (1) The applicant has completed successfully the medical 27 required studies of the preceding academic year and remains in good standing 28 as an enrolled student in the college or educational program; (2) 29 The applicant is enrolled or participating in a medically 30 underserved and rural practice curriculum, as applicable to the college or 31 educational program for which an applicant has been accepted for admission or in which an applicant is enrolled in good standing; 32 33 The applicant continues to be a resident of Arkansas; and (3) 34 The applicant's financial situation continues to warrant (4) financial assistance made under the conditions of this section. 35 36

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-81-708(c), concerning obligations and
conditions incorporated into a written loan contract granted by the Arkansas
Rural Medical Practice Student Loan and Scholarship Board, is amended to read
as follows:

5 (c) Each applicant to whom a rural medically underserved population 6 medical practice loan or loans is granted by the Arkansas Rural Medically 7 <u>Underserved Population</u> Medical Practice Student Loan and Scholarship Board 8 shall execute a written loan contract that incorporates the following 9 obligations and conditions:

10 (1)(A) The recipient of a rural medically underserved population 11 medical practice loan or loans shall bindingly contract that he or she shall 12 practice primary care medicine full time in a qualified rural community with 13 <u>a medically underserved population</u> upon completion of:

(i) For students who have been accepted for
admission to or are enrolled in good standing in the College of Medicine of
the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in studies leading to the
degree of Doctor of Medicine:

18 (i)(a) His or her medical internship of one (1) year 19 undertaken immediately following the earning of the degree of Doctor of 20 Medicine;

21 (ii)(b) Four (4) additional years of medical 22 training beyond the internship if the training has been approved in advance 23 by the Arkansas <u>Rural Medically Underserved Population</u> Medical Practice 24 Student Loan and Scholarship Board and includes practice experience in a 25 <del>rural</del> medically underserved population community; or

26 (iii)(c) At the request of the recipient of a rural 27 medically underserved population medical practice loan, the Arkansas Rural 28 Medically Underserved Population Medical Practice Student Loan and 29 Scholarship Board may approve the recipient's request to practice in more than one (1) qualified rural community with a medically underserved 30 31 population to meet his or her obligation to practice full time if the 32 Arkansas Rural Medically Underserved Population Medical Practice Student Loan 33 and Scholarship Board determines, based upon guidelines established by the 34 Arkansas Rural Medically Underserved Population Medical Practice Student Loan 35 and Scholarship Board, that the physician need in the rural communities with 36 a medically underserved population cannot sustain a full-time medical

1 practice or that other compelling circumstances exist; and 2 (ii) For students who have been accepted for admission to or are enrolled in good standing in a college or educational 3 4 program under §§ 6-81-706(a)(2)(B) or (C), the educational program and 5 accompanying requirements in which the students are enrolled. 6 (B) The recipient of a rural medically underserved 7 population medical practice loan or loans shall bindingly contract that for 8 each year's loan he or she shall practice medicine in accordance with 9 subdivision (c)(1)(A) of this section for a whole year. 10 (C) For each continuous whole year of medical practice, in 11 accordance with subdivision (c)(l)(A) of this section, subject to reasonable 12 leave periods, including without limitation vacation, sick leave, continuing 13 medical education, jury duty, funerals, holidays, or military service, the 14 Arkansas Rural Medically Underserved Population Medical Practice Student Loan 15 and Scholarship Board shall cancel, by converting to a scholarship grant, the 16 full amount of one (1) year's loan plus accrued interest; 17 (2)(A) The recipient of a rural medically underserved population 18 medical practice loan or loans shall bindingly contract that not engaging in 19 the practice of medicine in accordance with the loan contract and with this 20 subchapter may result in suspension of his or her license to practice 21 medicine in this state. 22 (B) For any contract entered into after August 1, 2007, 23 the recipient's medical license may shall not be suspended unless the 24 recipient's contract: 25 (i) Contract contained a specific term that loss of 26 license was is a consequence of breach; and the recipient 27 (ii) Recipient signed a written acknowledgment of 28 understanding that the suspension of license was explained to him or her 29 orally as a potential consequence of breach of the contractual provisions. 30 (C) The suspension may be for a period of years equivalent 31 to the number of years that the recipient is obligated to practice medicine 32 in a rural area community with a medically underserved population but has not 33 so practiced and until the loan with interest together with any civil money 34 penalties, as reduced by each full year of medical practice according to the 35 terms of the loan contract, is paid in full; 36 (3) Any communication from the University of Arkansas College of

Medicine with any state medical licensing board shall include a notation that the recipient of a <u>rural medically underserved population</u> medical practice loan has a contract with the State of Arkansas to practice medicine in a <u>rural community with a medically underserved population</u> and that breach of that contract may result in suspension of the recipient's Arkansas medical license;

7 (4)(A) In the event that any rural a medically underserved 8 population medical practice loan recipient under this subchapter does not 9 engage in the practice of medicine in accordance with the terms of this 10 section and of his or her loan contract in order to have the loan contract 11 recognized as a scholarship, the recipient shall remain obligated to repay 12 the loan or loans received, together with interest at the maximum rate 13 allowed by Arkansas law or the federal discount rate plus five percent (5%) 14 per annum, whichever is the lesser, the interest to accrue from the date each 15 payment of funds was received by the recipient.

16 (B) Neither interest nor the obligation to repay the 17 principal sums accrued shall accrue during any one (1) period of time that 18 the recipient involuntarily serves on active duty in the United States Armed 19 Forces.

20 (C) Repayment of principal with interest shall be due and 21 payable in full at the earliest to occur of the following events: 22 (i) Failure to remain enrolled in a medically 23 underserved and rural practice curriculum, as applicable to the college or 24 educational program for which an applicant has been accepted for admission or 25 in which an applicant is enrolled in good standing; 26 (ii) Failure to remain in enrollment status 27 continuously to completion of the a degree of Doctor of Medicine necessary to 28 meet eligibility criteria under this subchapter for any reason other than temporary personal illness; 29 30 (iii) Failure For students who have been accepted 31 for admission to or are enrolled in good standing in the College of Medicine

32 of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in studies leading to the

33 <u>degree of Doctor of Medicine, failure</u> to complete internship;
34 (iv)(a) Failure to engage in the <u>a</u> full-time
35 practice <del>of medicine</del> while residing in a <del>qualified rural</del> community <u>with a</u>

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1	(b) However, the Arkansas Rural Medically
