(3) Notification required under subdivisions (b)(2)(A) and (B) of this section shall be made at least two (2) hours before the meeting takes place in order that the public shall have representatives at the meeting. (4) As used in this subsection, "online" means a website or social media page that is owned or maintained by an entity or the governing body of an entity required to have public meetings under subsection (a) of this section.
