27	Tourism Subcommittee and in representing the citizens Crawford and Franklin
28	Counties advocated for the following funding for his district: ninety
29	thousand dollars (\$90,000) for the Cedarville Public Library Building Fund;
30	fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the Mulberry Public Library Building
31	Fund; and

33	WHEREAS, other notable accomplishments by Representative Prater
34	include: worked to reinstate state aid to public libraries after the funding
35	was cut; sponsored legislation requiring a fee for calling a special election
36	on a library tax issue; supported funding for fire departments, senior

     veterans housing, and health care; and fought along with his constituents

     against consolidation of small public schools in Crawford and Franklin

     restoration of the Cedarville Old Rock School House by gaining funding

     through grants for the use as a transitional home of the Cedarville Public

     Library and a community center for the Cedarville Public Schools, and was

     dedicated to the success of the Franklin County Fair; and
