7	HOUSE RESOLUTION
8	TO COMMEND AND CONGRATULATE THE MODERN STATE OF
9	ISRAEL ON THE OCCASION OF THE SEVENTY-FIFTH
10	ANNIVERSARY OF ITS ESTABLISHMENT, TO RECOGNIZE THE
11	CONTRIBUTIONS OF ISRAEL TO HUMANKIND, TO EXPRESS
12	SUPPORT FOR THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL FOR THEIR RIGHT TO
13	LIVE IN FREEDOM AND TO DEFEND THEIR LAND AND THEIR
14	COUNTRY, AND TO EXTEND BEST WISHES TO THE STATE OF
15	ISRAEL AND TO THE ISRAELI PEOPLE FOR A PEACEFUL AND
16	PROSPEROUS FUTURE.

20	TO CONGRATULATE THE STATE OF ISRAEL ON
21	THE OCCASION OF THE SEVENTY-FIFTH
22	ANNIVERSARY OF ITS ESTABLISHMENT AND TO
23	EXTEND BEST WISHES TO THE STATE OF ISRAEL
24	AND TO THE ISRAELI PEOPLE FOR A PEACEFUL
25	AND PROSPEROUS FUTURE.

27	
28	WHEREAS, what is now the modern State of Israel was historically
29	granted her lands under and through the oldest recorded deed, as found in the
30	Holy Bible, which is a tome of scripture revered by Jews and Christians alike
31	as presenting the acts and words of God; and
32	
33	WHEREAS, the desire of the Jewish people to establish an independent
34	modern State of Israel is directly linked to the existence of the historic
35	Kingdom of Israel established in the Land of Israel more than three thousand
36	years (3,000) ago, with the City of Jerusalem as its capital both then and



1	now; and
2	
3	WHEREAS, for more than two thousand (2,000) years, Jews living in other
4	parts of the world maintained a profound spiritual and emotional connection
5	to the Land of Israel, and there has been continuous Jewish presence in the
6	land comprising the modern State of Israel; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, the internationally recognized legal basis for the
9	establishment of the modern State of Israel was a binding resolution under
10	international law that was unanimously adopted by the League of Nations in
11	1922 and subsequently affirmed by both houses of the United States Congress;
12	and
13	
14	WHEREAS, this binding resolution affirmed the establishment of a
15	national home for the Jewish people in the historical region of the Land of
16	Israel, including the areas of Judea, Samaria, and eastern Jerusalem; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, on May 14, 1948, the people of Israel proclaimed the
19	establishment of the sovereign and independent State of Israel with the goal
20	of reestablishing its God-given and legally recognized land as a homeland for
21	the Jewish people; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, the establishment of the modern State of Israel as a homeland
24	for the Jewish people followed the destruction of much of the European Jewry
25	during the Holocaust; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the United States Government established full diplomatic
28	relations after the State of Israel's first election in 1949; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, since its establishment seventy-five (75) years ago, the
31	modern State of Israel has forged a new and dynamic society and created a
32	thriving economic, political, cultural, and intellectual life; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, the people of the State of Israel, in the spirit of the State
35	of Israel's Declaration of the Establishment of the State of Israel, have
36	established a vibrant, pluralistic, democratic political system; and

2	WHEREAS, the State of Israel has developed an advanced, entrepreneurial
3	economy, is among the world's leaders of the high-tech industry, and is at
4	the forefront of research and development in the fields of renewable energy
5	sources and medicine; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, the State of Israel regularly sends humanitarian aid, search
8	and rescue teams, mobile hospitals, and other emergency supplies to help
9	victims of disasters around the world; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, the State of Israel has taken in millions of Jews from
12	countries throughout the world and sought to fully integrate them into
13	Israeli society; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, the State of Israel has long-established peaceful bilateral
16	relations with Egypt and Jordan, and has more recently established peace with
17	Bahrain, Morocco, the United Arab Emirates, and Sudan, and has worked toward
18	achieving a secure, peaceful relationship with the Palestinian people, and is
19	looking forward to normalizing relations with all other Arab neighbors in
20	pursuit of enduring regional stability and prosperity; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, for seven (7) decades, the United States, the State of
23	Arkansas, and the State of Israel have maintained a special relationship
24	based on mutually shared democratic and moral values, common strategic
25	interests, and bonds of friendship and mutual respect; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the United States and the State of Arkansas continue to regard
28	the State of Israel as a trusted ally and vital strategic partner in the
29	Middle East; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, the American people and the people of Arkansas feel a strong
32	affinity for the Israeli people based on common values and shared cultural
33	heritage; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas again wishes to reaffirm its desire that

the United States of America remains a strong and unequivocal supporter of

1	the State of Israel and the right of Israel to defend itself in its own
2	country; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, nightfall of the 25th day of April through the evening of the
5	26th day of April 2023, the fifth day of Iyar, 5783 of the Hebrew calendar,
6	marks the seventy-fifth anniversary of the founding of the modern State of
7	Israel in the ancestral homeland of the Jewish people,
8	
9	NOW THEREFORE,
10	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL
11	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
12	
13	THAT the House of Representatives congratulate the State of Israel on
14	the occasion of the seventy-fifth anniversary of its establishment, recognize
15	the contributions of the State of Israel to humankind, express support for
16	the people of the State of Israel for their right to live in freedom and to
17	defend their land and their country, and extend its best wishes to the State
18	of Israel and to the Israeli people for a peaceful and prosperous future.
19	
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a copy of this resolution shall be transmitted to
21	the Consul General of the State of Israel to the Southwest in Houston, Texas,
22	and to the Embassy of Israel to the United States in Washington, D.C., for
23	transmission to the proper authorities in the State of Israel by the Chief
24	Clerk of the House.
