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1 2 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - GOVERNOR'S EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION. There is 3 hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the 4 Miscellaneous Revolving Fund, for the purpose provided by Arkansas Code 19-2-5 404, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, the following: 6 7 ITEM FISCAL YEAR 8 2023-2024 NO. 9 (01) GOVERNOR'S EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION \$500,000 10 11 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 13 TRANSFER PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer 14 of the State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 15 Budget Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any 16 line item authorized in Operations Appropriation of the Governor's Office in 17 this Act to any other line item authorized in Operations Appropriation. 18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2022 19 2023 through June 30, <del>2023</del> 2024. 20 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 25, 21 22 Chapter 16, Subchapter 2, is amended to add an additional section to codify 23 special language in appropriation acts to read as follows: 24 25-16-207. Maximum salary increase. 25 To recruit and retain exceptionally well-qualified personnel, the 26 office of the Governor may exceed the maximum salary level of personnel if: 27 (1) The maximum salary is increased by no more than twenty 28 percent (20%); 29 (2) The maximum salary increase is requested for no more than 30 one-third (1/3) of the positions authorized in the operation appropriation 31 act for the office of the Governor; and 32 (3) The Office of the Governor receives approval for the maximum 33 salary increase from the Legislative Council or, if the General Assembly is 34 in session, the Joint Budget Committee. 35 36 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

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1 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 3 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

10 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18

19 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 20 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm 25 26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 28 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023. 29 30 31 */s/Joint Budget Committee* 32 33 34

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
