EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 16 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the 17 State Police Retirement System law do not comport with existing laws 18 concerning the administration of benefits and are in need of revision and 19 updating to maintain the retirement laws in conformance with sound public 20 pension policy; that the State Police Retirement System operates on a fiscal year of July 1 to June 30; that having a July 1, 2023 effective date is 21 22 necessary to allow the provisions within this act to begin on the first day 23 of the fiscal year in order to provide proper administration of the procedures herein; that such revisions and updating are of great importance 24 25 for actuarial purposes and to protect the benefits of members of the State 26 Police Retirement System; and that it is necessary for this act to have a 27 July 1, 2023 effective date in order to maintain an orderly system of benefits for the members of the State Police Retirement System. Therefore, 28 29 an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the 30 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2023. 31 32 33 34 35 36

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
