SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL, AND TEMPORARY LAW. PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS CLASSIFIED STAFF RATES OF PAY. Beginning with the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the Department of Education shall advise all public school districts to pay a minimum rate for all classified employees of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per hour and shall revise this required rate every year thereafter to increase based on the growth percentage of the Consumer Price Index as described in Arkansas Code § 6-17-2203.
