9	AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING RETIREMENT
10	BENEFITS; TO PROHIBIT COLLECTION OF BENEFITS BY
11	MEMBERS, RETIRANTS, OR BENEFICIARIES OF RETIREMENT
12	SYSTEMS WHO ARE CONVICTED OF CERTAIN OFFENSES; AND
13	FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
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16	Subtitle
17	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING RETIREMENT
18	BENEFITS; AND TO PROHIBIT COLLECTION OF
19	BENEFITS BY MEMBERS, RETIRANTS, OR
20	BENEFICIARIES OF RETIREMENT SYSTEMS WHO
21	ARE CONVICTED OF CERTAIN OFFENSES.
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24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-1-301, concerning the definitions used
27	in the forfeiture of retirement benefits, is amended to add additional
28	subdivisions to read as follows:
29	(3)(A) "Benefit" means a monthly payment made to a retirant or
30	the beneficiary of a member or retirant by a retirement system.
31	(B) "Benefit" does not include employee contributions to a
32	retirement system;
33	(4) "Member" means a person who is included in the membership of
34	a retirement system;
35	(5)(A) "Public office" means an office created by or under the
36	authority of the laws of the State of Arkansas or a subdivision thereof that

1	is filled by a person who is elected by the voters of the State of Arkansas.
2	(B) "Public office" does not include an office created by
3	or under the authority of any federal law;
4	(6) "Public trust crime" means a crime prohibited under Arkansas
5	Constitution, Article 5, § 9; and
6	(7) "Retirant" means a member who retires with a benefit payable
7	from funds of a retirement plan.
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9	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-1-302 is amended to read as follows:
10	24-1-302. Forfeiture of benefits.
11	(a)(1) A member or retirant forfeits his or her right to benefit
12	payments under a retirement system if he or she pleads guilty or nolo
13	contendere to or is found guilty of a public trust crime while holding public
14	office in this state.
15	(2) A beneficiary forfeits his or her right to benefit payments
16	under a retirement system if he or she:
17	(A) Is convicted by a court of competent jurisdiction of
18	the unlawful killing of the member or retirant Pleads guilty or nolo
19	contendere to or is found guilty of the unlawful killing of a member or
20	<u>retirant</u> ;
21	(B) Pleads guilty or nolo contendere to the unlawful
22	killing of the member or retirant Pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or is
23	found guilty of a public trust crime while holding public office in this
24	state, unless he or she is participating in a retirement system defined under
25	$\S 24-1-301(2)(F);$
26	(C) Is found liable by a court of competent jurisdiction
27	for the unlawful killing <u>wrongful death</u> of the member or retirant by a
28	preponderance of the evidence in a civil action;.
29	(D) Is acquitted by a court of competent jurisdiction for
30	the unlawful killing of the member or retirant by reason of insanity, mental
31	defect or disease, or any other mental incapacity; or
32	(E) Is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to lack
33	the capacity to understand or effectively assist in defending a criminal
34	proceeding against him or her for the unlawful killing of the member or
35	retirant.
36	$\frac{(2)(3)}{(3)}$ If a retirement system finds that a member, retirant, or

1	beneficiary has forfeited his or her right to benefit payments from the
2	retirement system under subdivision (a)(1) subsection (a) of this section,
3	the retirement system shall treat the beneficiary as if he or she is
4	deceased :
5	(A) and shall not Not make benefit payments to the member,
6	retirant, or beneficiary+; and
7	(B) Refund the employee contributions accumulated with
8	interest as defined by the retirement system that were made by the member or
9	retirant to the retirement system to the:
10	(i) Member or retirant; or
11	(ii) If deceased, the estate of the member or
12	retirant if the member or retirant does not have a contingent beneficiary who
13	may receive benefit payments under this section.
14	(C) If a retirant is already receiving benefits, then his
15	or her employee contributions, less benefits received by the retirant through
16	the retirement system, shall be refunded to him or her in full.
17	(4)(A) A retirement system may make the refund of employee
18	contributions accumulated with interest as defined by the retirement system
19	to a member or retirant by a:
20	(i) Lump-sum payment to the member or retirant; or
21	(ii) Series of monthly payments to the member or
22	retirant in amounts equal to the amount the individual paid in to the
23	retirement system with an interest rate as defined by the retirement system.
24	(B) A retirement system shall make the refund of employee
25	contributions to the estate of a member or retirant by a lump-sum payment to
26	the estate of the member or retirant.
27	(C) Payments made under subdivision (a)(4)(A) of this
28	section shall cease when the member or retirant is fully reimbursed for his
29	or her employee contributions paid in to the retirement system with an
30	interest rate as defined by the retirement system.
31	(b)(l) If a member, retirant, or beneficiary appeals his or her
32	conviction for an offense <u>or a judgment</u> described under subdivision (a)(1)
33	subdivision (a)(1) or (a)(2) of this section, benefit payments shall not be
34	paid to the $\underline{\text{member, retirant, or}}$ beneficiary unless the appeal results in a
35	reversal of the conviction or judgment.
36	(2)(A) If the conviction of a member, retirant, or beneficiary

1	for an offense or a judgment described under subdivision (a)(1) subdivision
2	(a)(1) or $(a)(2)$ of this section is reversed, the retirement system may make
3	benefit payments to the member, retirant, or beneficiary upon repayment of
4	accumulated contributions with interest to the system.
5	(B) If the conviction of a member, retirant, or
6	beneficiary for an offense or a judgment described under subdivision (a)(1)
7	subdivision (a)(1) or (a)(2) of this section is affirmed, the retirement
8	system shall not make benefit payments to the member, retirant, or
9	beneficiary.
10	(c) If a member or retirant does not have a contingent beneficiary who
11	may receive benefit payments under this section, the member or retirant's
12	contributions to the retirement system shall be refunded to the estate of the
13	member or retirant.
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15	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Legislative intent.</u>
16	It is the intent of the General Assembly that this act not be construed
17	to apply retroactively to a member or retirant of a retirement system, and
18	shall only apply to a member or retirant who begins making employee
19	contributions following this act's enactment.
