It is found and determined by the General 33 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Tax Appeals Commission is in the 34 process of setting up to begin receiving and hearing appeals in January 2023, 35 and that this act is immediately necessary to provide for appointments of commissioners upon vacancy. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, 36
