15 TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF
16 "INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL
17 DISABILITY" IN THE ARKANSAS CODE.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-48-101(4), concerning the definition of
23 "intellectual and developmental disability", is amended to read as follows:

24 (4) "Intellectual and developmental disability" means a chronic
25 disability of ~~a person~~ an individual that:

26 (A) ~~(i) Is attributable to an impairment of general~~
27 ~~intellectual functioning or adaptive behavior, including cerebral palsy,~~
28 ~~spina bifida, Down syndrome, epilepsy, or autism;~~

29 ~~(ii) Is attributable to any other condition of a~~
30 ~~person found to be closely related to intellectual and developmental~~
31 ~~disability because the condition results in an impairment of general~~
32 ~~intellectual functioning or adaptive behavior similar to that of a person~~
33 ~~with an intellectual and developmental disability or requires treatment and~~
34 ~~services similar to that required for a person with an intellectual and~~
35 ~~developmental disability; or~~

36 ~~(iii) Is attributable to dyslexia resulting from a~~



1 ~~disability described in subdivision (4)(A)(i) or subdivision (4)(A)(ii) of~~
2 ~~this section;~~ a diagnosis of one (1) of the following:

3 (i) Cerebral palsy, as established by the results of
4 a medical examination by the individual's primary care provider or a licensed
5 physician;

6 (ii) Epilepsy, as established by the results of a
7 neurological examination by the individual's primary care provider or a
8 licensed physician;

9 (iii) Spina bifida, as established by the results of
10 medical examination by the individual's primary care provider or a licensed
11 physician;

12 (iv) Down syndrome, as established by the results of
13 a medical examination by the individual's primary care provider or a licensed
14 physician;

15 (v) Autism spectrum disorder, as established under §
16 20-77-124; or

17 (vi) Intellectual disability, causing an impairment
18 of general function similar to that of persons with a developmental
19 disability, as established for an individual from:

20 (a) Birth to three (3) years of age, by a
21 score on an age-appropriate standardized assessment administered within the
22 past twelve (12) months that indicates a developmental delay of twenty-five
23 percent (25%) of the child's chronological age or greater in two (2) or more
24 of the following developmental domains:

25 (1) Cognitive;

26 (2) Communicative;

27 (3) Adaptive;

28 (4) Social or emotional; and

29 (5) Physical;

30 (b) Three (3) to five (5) years of age, by a
31 score on an age-appropriate assessment administered within the past twelve
32 (12) months that indicates functioning on a level two (2) or more standard
33 deviations from the mean in two (2) or more areas; or

34 (c) Five (5) years of age and older, by a
35 full-scale standard intelligence score of seventy (70) or below, as measured
36 by a standard test designed for individual administration;

1 (B) Originates before the person attains twenty-two (22)
2 years of age;

3 (C) Has continued or can be expected to continue
4 indefinitely; and

5 (D) Constitutes a substantial impairment to the person's
6 ability to function without appropriate support services, including, ~~but not~~
7 ~~limited to, planned recreational activities, medical~~ without limitation:

8 (i) Daily living and social activities;

9 (ii) Medical services such as physical therapy and
10 speech therapy;

11 (iii) Job training; and ~~sheltered employment or job~~
12 ~~training~~

13 (iv) Employment;

15 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-48-202(4) and (5), concerning the
16 definitions of "individual with developmental and intellectual disability"
17 and "intellectual and developmental disability", are amended to read as
18 follows:

19 (4)~~(A)~~ "Individual with intellectual and developmental
20 disabilities" means+

21 ~~(i) A person with a mental deficit requiring him or~~
22 ~~her to have special evaluation, treatment, care, education, training,~~
23 ~~supervision, or control in his or her home or community, or in a state~~
24 ~~institution for persons with intellectual disabilities; or~~

25 ~~(ii) A person with intellectual and developmental~~
26 ~~disabilities who may not exhibit an intellectual deficit on standard~~
27 ~~psychological tests but who, because of other handicaps, functions as a~~
28 ~~person with intellectual disabilities.~~

29 ~~(B) "Individual with intellectual and developmental~~
30 ~~disabilities" does not include a person whose primary condition is caused by~~
31 ~~mental illness, emotional disturbance, physical handicap, or sensory defect a~~
32 person with an intellectual and developmental disability;

33 (5) "Intellectual and developmental disability" means the same
34 as defined in § ~~20-48-603~~ 20-48-101;

36 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-48-603(2), concerning the definition of

1 "intellectual and developmental disability", is amended to read as follows:

2 (2)~~(A)~~ "Intellectual and developmental disability" means a
3 ~~disability of a person that:~~

4 ~~(i) Is attributable to an impairment of general~~
5 ~~intellectual functioning or adaptive behavior, including cerebral palsy,~~
6 ~~spina bifida, Down syndrome, epilepsy, or autism;~~

7 ~~(ii) Is attributable to any other condition of a~~
8 ~~person found to be closely related to intellectual and developmental~~
9 ~~disability because the condition results in impairment of general~~
10 ~~intellectual functioning or adaptive behavior similar to that of individuals~~
11 ~~with intellectual and developmental disabilities or requires treatment and~~
12 ~~services similar to those required for the persons;~~

13 ~~(iii) Is attributable to dyslexia resulting from~~
14 ~~intellectual and developmental disability, cerebral palsy, epilepsy, or~~
15 ~~autism; and~~

16 ~~(iv) Has continued or can be expected to continue~~
17 ~~indefinitely.~~

18 ~~(B) "Intellectual and developmental disability" does not~~
19 ~~refer to other forms of mental disease or defect not defined in this section~~
20 ~~the same as defined in § 20-48-101;~~
